MANHEIM SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION RANGE RULES AND ORIENTATION

GENERAL

- Ranges are for paid members only. Current membership cards are the only proof of membership and must be posted on the clips while shooting on the range.
- No hunting or trapping on the club property without the Board of Directors approval.
- The club house may be rented by members or nonmembers.
- No alcohol is allowed on the club property at any time.

RIFLE, ARCHERY AND PISTOL RANGE RULES AND SAFETY PROCEDURES

1. Archery range: No firearms permitted. Firearm range: No archery permitted.
2. No shooting while under the influence of any substance that hinders your shooting ability.
3. Outdoor range hours: 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on weekdays and Saturdays.
12:00 noon until 6:00 p.m. on Sundays.
4. Members under the age of 16 must be directly supervised by a parent or legal guardian.
5. Be courteous: Worn other shooters before you shoot: don't occupy more than one rifle bench at a time: don't interrupt someone's concentration or shooting and limit your shooting when other's are waiting to shoot.
6. All members shall police the ranges, ask for membership cards if not posted and show your card when asked and report any violation of range rules or misconduct to any officer. Be polite and courteous when asking for membership cards.
7. Put used targets, beverage containers, brass or boxes in their proper containers.
8. All firearms not properly zeroed in must first be shot from the 50-yard bench.
9. Do not handle firearms without permission of the owner.
10. Explosive bullets or explosive targets are not permitted.
11. Muzzles are to be pointed down range at all times.
12. Actions must be open and empty except when firing.
13. No fully-automatic firearms permitted.
14. Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times.
15. Patterning of shotguns is to be done only with patterning boards,

SAFETY

- Know your firearm: how to load, use the safety, operate semi-automatics. Don't come to the range and try to figure out how to fire it.
- ALL rifles, shotguns and pistols shall be unloaded with action open when not firing.
- Load only one round at a time when sighting in rifles.
- Keep muzzles pointed down range at all times.
- No discharging of firearms into the air or into the ground at the benches, aim and fire in the direction of the designated target areas.
- When checking your targets, leave the firearm on the bench, rack or gun case with the action open so that everyone on the range knows that the firearm is safe. This includes side arms. No shooter should be walking on the range with a loaded gun.
- When posting targets or retrieving targets let others using the range know of your intentions: don't just walk down range and hope they see you.
- No shooting on range when work detail is scheduled or the "RANGE CLOSED" sign is posted.
- All firing of firearms must be done from under the roof.

**Violations of these rules will be reviewed by the Board and could result in immediate
And permanent loss of membership!!!!**
